The Academic session 2020-21 commenced on 1st April 2020 with new horizons, a year full of dreams, aspirations and successes to be achieved.

The noteworthy achievements of the school towards the end of the eventful year can be summed up in the following manner.

ACADEMICS

The students of XII and X gave an exemplary performance in their boards.



In the Senior Secondary CBSE Board examination we had 201 students who appeared in the session 2019-20. The highest percentage scored was 96.6% in Non-Medical, 95.8% in Medical, 97.8% in Commerce and 97.4% in Humanities. 75 students scored above 90% and 146 students scored above 80%.

In the Secondary Board Examination 181 students appeared. Our student Kripi Singla scored 906% marks. 22 students scored above 90% and 80 above 80%. 7 Students scored 100 marks in different subjects.

It is a matter of great pride that three of our students cleared the NEET Medical Entrance Examination to get admission in Government Medical Colleges. Our students also got admission in IIT Bombay and NIT Kurukshetra.

Steps taken to improve Academic Performance

- Remedial classes are taken about two months before the board exams to improve academic result.
- Teaching sessions related to each subject's curriculum are planned by the subject teachers to cater to the learning needs and problems of students to boost the confidence level of slow learners.
- > Regular tests and assessments are taken as a part of curriculum.
- A variety of High Order Thinking Assignments in each subject are given to widen the learning horizon and enhance performance level.
- Seminars for good study habits and learning tips are organized regularly in which experts are invited to guide the students.
- Under the guidance of DAV Centre for Academic Excellence, New Delhi, Content and Need based Seminars and QPI Enhancement Capacity Building Programmes are organized to update the teachers' knowledge and teaching strategies thereby uplifting the academic results.
- Departmental meetings are regularly held by subject teachers to plan and share teaching methods and curriculum.
