- Preliminary Round to select Four students will be held on 11.11.2019.
- Judgement Criteria: Content, Confidence, Expressions, Costume, Props and Presentation.
- Duration: 2mins
- 1 (b) Sound Blend Town
 - Individual Competitive Event.
 - Students will draw and create a scene with minimum Five pictures of words related to any one sound blend.

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 - Material Required: Labelled white A4 Size Sheet, Colours, Sketch Pens and Other Material as Per Requirement.
 - Judgement Criteria: Concept, Neatness, Presentation.
 - Time Duration: $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours

Note- Students participating in 'Right from the Heart' will not participate in 'Sound Blend Town'.
