- 1. To prepare stained temporary mounts of Human cheek cells & onion peel & record observations and draw labelled diagrams.
- 2. To identify parenchyma and sclerenchyma tissue (plants), striped muscle fibres and nerve cells in animals, from prepared slides and to draw their labelled diagrams.
- To study the characteristic of spirogyra, Agaricus, Moss, Fern, Pinus (male or female cone) and an Angiospermic plant.
  Draw and give two identifying features of groups they belong to.
- 4. To observe and draw the given specimens earthworm, cockroach, bony fish and bird. For each specimen record
  - a) one specific feature of its phylum,
  - b) one adaptive feature with reference to its habitat.
