#### SCHOOL TERM AND ASSESSMENT FOR LKG to Std. II

The Academic Session for LKG to Std. II has three Terms – Term I (April to July), Term II (August to November) & Term III (December to March) where the performance of the child is assessed throughout the year through continuous process of evaluation and co-curricular activities. Emphasis is given on activity based teaching – learning process.

### FOR CLASSES III to XII

The Academic Session is divided into two Terms as follows:

1st Term – April to September

2nd Term - October to March

The assessment structure of Std. III -VIII is as per guidelines of DAV Centre of Academic Excellence, DAV CMC New Delhi.

The assessment structure of Std. IX -XII is as per guidelines of CBSE, New Delhi. However, Std. XI Annual Assessment is conducted centrally under DAV Centre of Academic Excellence, DAV CMC New Delhi.

### CURRICULUM

- The curriculum and books from LKG to Std. VIII are designed by DAV Centre of Academic Excellence, New Delhi.
- 2. From LKG to Std. VIII students have to study two languages i.e., English (compulsory) and

Bengali / Hindi (2nd language). For Std. V-VIII, Sanskrit is compulsory 3rd Language.

- 3. As an integral part of the curriculum children are taught English language, Environmental Science, Conversation, Recitation, Spellings, Handwriting, Mathematics & 2nd Language with the help of variety of audio-visual teaching aids.
- Keeping in mind, the physical fitness and allround development of the children, various indoor and outdoor games, yoga, HPE, dance and music have been incorporated in the curriculum.
- 5. Std. IX to XII curriculum is as per CBSE, New Delhi.
