It is a profound honour for me in presenting the Annual Report – 2018-19 to appraise you all a glimpse of our progress and accomplishments in this session.

DAV Public School Pokhariput Bhubaneswar is one of the the shining sparks of DAV Movement founded by Vedic exponents of Arya Samaj to uphold the lofty ideals of Renaissance Saint Swami Dayananda Saraswati to liberalize Indian cultural values and integrate Scientific temper to create a transformational educational setup on a global scale. With the same zest and zeal, our school has undergone a complete metamorphosis within 27 years from its modest birth in 1992.Today, the campus of DAV Public School, Pokhariput has been a heart of student activities in a highly secured and hygienic ambience with a 2600 strong student community hailing from all over the state. It's a boundless joy to mention that with the timely guidance and involvement of our Regional officer and the Chairman of the school managing committee and good wishes of all stake holders we have annexed a sprawling 2 acres of land to our existing 3-acre campus dreaming to extend more and advanced sporting facilities for our dear children.

Education is a shared commitment between dedicated teachers, motivated students and enthusiastic parents. We are deeply grateful to our parent community for their unstinted support and constructive relationship with the school to muster its courage to be one of the leading educational establishments of the nation.

#### Scholastic Successes

- I feel euphoric to mention that this year,our Class XII Science stream flaunted 100% result and the school average stood at 82.89%. In Science MasterPratyush Mishra topped the class with 96.4% marks followed by Master SaswatDas at 2<sup>nd</sup>position with 96.2% andMaster DebankitPriyadarshi held the 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 95.6%.
- 2. In Commerce, Master Surag Das topped the school with 94% with Master Ashish Aman at 2<sup>nd</sup> position with 92.8% and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the stream went to Master Jaganmoy Pattnaik with secured 91.4% marks. The school average touched 78.71% in commerce.
- 3. According to the Performance Analysis of DAVCMC, our school has been placed as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Best School in the outstanding category of Group IV (which means a School having student strength of 160 to 240) and has been conferred upon the crown of '**PRIDE OF DAV**'.
- 4. Besides these brilliant results in Class XII, our students also shone brightly in various **competitive examinations**like JEE- Advance and Main, NEET, BITS Pilani, NISER,Indian Statistical Institute and KVPY.

- In a circumstance when CBSE scraped CCE reintroducing marks instead of grades in Class X, 74 students secured90% and above and 140 students got 80% and above out of 185 students who appeared CBSE Class X Examination and the School average stood at 84.65%.
- 6. Miss SaswatiSubhalaxmi topped the school and was 2<sup>nd</sup>in DAV Odisha Zone with 98.8% of marks in Class X. The 2<sup>nd</sup> position was shared by Miss Kritika Patnaik and Miss Atisma Aishwarya with 98.2% and the 3<sup>rd</sup> position went to Miss Lopita Mohapatra who got 97.4% marks.
- 7. 4 students in Maths, 2 students in science, 3 students in SST and 10 students in Sanskrit grabbed perfect 100 on 100 marks in these subjects.
- 8. Besides the illustrious show in the board examinations, our intelligent lineupcomprisingMaster Ashutosh Mishra and Master SubhamSubhasis Sahoo qualified**NTSE**, a dream accomplishment by anyclass 10 student.

- 1. As we build responsible citizens of the future, **NCC**, **Scout**, **Guide and Redcross** come a long way to make them selfless patriots of the soil. I feel elated to mention that ours is the only school to have 5 wings of NCC.
- 2. Adding icing to the cake, NCC Girls' wing has won the Chief Minister's Running Shield consecutively for the 6<sup>th</sup> time in State level Republic Day Parade. And same holds true for Army Boys' wing who has won it for 4<sup>th</sup> time this year.
- 3. Army JW cadet Miss Ananya Panda got CWS Scholarship and received Rajiv Gandhi PrativaPuraskar -2018.

- It's my immense pleasure to mention that our studentMiss Anshika Mohapatra of Class 7 represented India in Karate Championship at 9<sup>th</sup> Commonwealth Games 2018 at Durban, South Africa and won 2 Gold medals both in individual and team events in under 14 years category.
- SimilarlyMasterRudra Prasad of class 5 won a bronze medal at the same Commonwealth Games 2018 in under 14 team Karate events representing India. He was also the winner of 1<sup>st</sup> position in National Level Karate Championship – 2018.
- 3. **Miss P. Arpita Archana Sahoo** of Class 9, the Golden Girl of DAV Pokhariput won Gold medal in Putting the Shot event at DAV National Sports -2018 held at Sahibabad, Delhi. Out of her number of achievements, a few are her gold medal in Long Jump at CBSE Cluster Meet -2018, her best athlete medal at DAV National Zonal Sports Meet -2018 and her Silver Medal in Shot Put in School State Athletic Meet organized by Govt. of Odisha.
- In CBSE East Zone Skating Competition Miss Sanvi Mishra of standard 4 got 2<sup>nd</sup> position. Likewise, in CBSE Zonal Competition in One Thousand meter skating race Master Kamalesh Sahoo of standard 2 got 3<sup>rd</sup> position.

DAV National Zonal Sports Meet 2018 was held at various venues of the state and ourKho-Kho Girls' team won the Championship trophy, Master NikhileshNayak of Class 9 and Master Kamalesh Nayak of Class 5 won boys'championships in 500 meter and 1000 meter skating events respectively. In girls' category Miss Saanvi Mishra Class 4 and Miss Tammana Priyadarshini of class 8 got the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places respectively in 500 meter skating. Master Bikash Kumar Sahoo of Class XII got the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize in long jump.
