LIBRARY RULES

 to XII can borrow two books at the same time from the library for seven days.
- Students are not allowed to bring their personal books inside the Library.
- Students may issue their books in library period, zero period and one hour after the school gets over.

LIBRARY RULES

- students are required to check the book at the time of getting issued. Damage, if any, should be reported immediately. In case of loss/damage of the issued book, the students have to pay the cost as well as fine on the book in question
- If renewing a book, students must have the book with them to renew. Books may be renewed only twice. No renewal is given if other member has reserved for the same book.
- Books are to be returned on due date mentioned on the issue
 Ievel. A fine of Rs. 1/- per day is imposed on any book returned
 after the due date.
