Foreword

Value education is one of the most notable components of the entire school curriculum. Basic values and virtues such as honesty, self-control, respect, responsibility, loyalty, etc are necessary for overall personality enhancement of a child. These values are interwoven through the medium of fun activities, for instance, stories and puppet shows, in the areas of language development, cognitive development, creative and expressive arts, physical development and socio-emotional development.

Mass activities are activities meticulously designed to ensure the holistic development of the students by boosting their confidence, self-esteem, removal of stage fright and enhancement of language. Class Teachers maintain a record of every child's participation and achievement in these mass activities. Besides this, important days are celebrated throughout the year to spread awareness about various issues prevalent on our planet to create a community of informed individuals and creating sensitivity among them.

Engaging in games can be another brilliant approach of enhancing learning abilities in children. Through sports children learn important life lessons and skills, develop a problem-solving attitude, get to explore the nature and acquire new information. EVALUATION SCHEME

The evaluation for Pre School & Pre Primary classes is continuous and comprehensive assessment of the growth and development of the child in various areas of learning set in the curriculum. Its aim is to measure the level attained by the child in different areas, continuously throughout the year. The curriculum emphasis on the overall growth and developmentof the child. Our curriculum is designed to encourage learning outcomes that focus on nurturing children to develop holistically, morally, aesthetically and globally including knowledge acquisition and academic skills.

- The academic session is divided into three terms: Term I – April to August Term II – September to December Term III – January to March
- There will be no formal exam for Pre School/Pre Primary classes. Child's progress is measured by the teacher's ongoing observation over the whole year, and not on a single test. Each term assessment Progress report card is based on the continuous evaluation based on class activities, worksheets, assignments on day to day basis.
