Registration

TEST/INTERVIEW

Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit. Admission is on the basis of written test and an interview. There is no written test for admission to Preparatory Classes. However, the candidate has to appear for an interactive session along with parents. Students offered admission must complete the admission formalities within the stipulated date or the offer will stand cancelled.

PAYMENT OF FEES
