IN SCIENCE- 70 marks theory written & 30 marks practical

IN COMMERCE- 80 marks theory written and 20marks practical.

- 3. Every student has to appear and obtain 33% marks in Theory and practical separately in each examination to qualify the exam.
- 4. Final result of STD.XI will be prepare as per the weight age given UNIT TEST -10% HALF YEARLY -30% ANNUAL EXAM -60%
- 5. DAVCAE will conduct year end exam for class XI.
- 6. Attendance for the students should not be less than 75% every month. Students who are caught doing malpractices in any of the exam will be awarded zero in that subject and debarred from appearing in all other subject exams. Also student will face very strict disciplinary action from the school.
