As the session resumes, kindly note the following points.

1- Replacements and changes in class teacher or subject teachers will be conveyed by respective teachers.

2- I am sure you understand the importance of internal assessments and ongoing participation and performance in school based exams/projects/activities specially in the current situation. The class X and XII marks as per CBSE policy are being decided as per this basis this year. I request you to ensure no laxity and that your ward is regular and attentive in all the above.

3- It is very important that your ward keeps the video on during class. Not following the new normal classroom etiquettes may lead to loss of attendance or strict action.

4- Any serious problem or matter may be shared with the concerned teacher or mailed to school for our perusal.

5- The Terminal/Periodical exams begin from 10 June onwards. It is mandatory for all students to appear in the exams. In case of any emergency or health issue, the teacher must be informed in time or else the child will be marked absent.

6- It is again mandatory for the child to log in at right time, keep video on, be in proper school uniform and obey the instructions of the teacher. Not doing so may lead to being marked absent. Kindly resolve matters related to the same in time. Any other problem may be immediately conveyed to the teacher on invigilation duty.
