- Ans. To create a new scenario, follow the given steps:

- (ii) From the Filters list at the top of the Templates dialog, optionally select a Category.
- (iii) Find and double-click on the required template. A new document based on the selected template opens in Writer. You can then edit and save the new document just as you would in any other document.
