Star 'dance' around black hole confirms Einstein's theory

SWNMG: Astronomers in Chile using one of the world's largest telescopes have found astar 'dancing' around a black hole in the Milky Way just as Albert Einstein might have prodicted more than a century ago. Einstein's General Theory of Relativity, published in 1955, is a foundation of mod-tion of the start of the start of the Burt Thursday's announcement from the European Southern Observatory (ESO), an intergovernmental group of European astronomers that operates in Chile, proves the theory applies even to a star some 26,000 light years from the Sun. WASHINGTON: Nasa on Friday set a launch date of May 27 for its first astronaut mis-sion from US soil in nearly ten years. sion from US soil in nearly ten years. WASHINGTON/NEW DELH: Scientists have dis WASHKTON/NEWDEUK: Scientists have dis-covered six new coronaviruses in hats in Myanmar — the first time these viruses have been found anywhere in the world. The findings will help understand the diversity of coronaviruses in hats and inform global efforts to detect, prevent and respond to infectious diseases that may threaten public health, particularly in light of the ongoing Covid-19 gan-demic. TIMOTHY JOHN BERNERS-LEE: This pioneering computer scientist was on the Time list of the 100 Most Important People of the 20th century. The Professorial Fellow in Computer Science at Oxford, MIT professor and fellow of the Royal Society was knighted in 2004.

enstrate it, he built a prototype sys-tem named ENQUIRE. After leav-ing CENN in 1980, he worked at John Pools's Image Computer Sys-tems, Ltd, in Bournemouth, Dor-set. In 1980, CERN was the largest internet node in Europe, and Bern-ers-Les saw an opportunity to join hypertext with the internet.

WORLD WIDE WEB Berners-Lee wrote his proposal in March 1989 and, in 1990, redistrib-utedit. It then was accepted by his manager, Mike Sendall, who called his proposals 'vague but exciting . He used similar ideas to those underlying the ENQUIRE system to create the World Wide Web, for which he designed and built the first Web browser. His software also functionedas as neditor (called

Inst web browser. Ins satiware also functioned as a neditor (called World Wide Web, running on the NeXTSTEP operating system), and the first Web server, CERN HTTPd (short far Hypertext Transfer Pro-tocol daemon).

Born an June 8, 1955, in Lan-don, he is the eldest of four-tists Mary Lee Woods and Canway Berners-Lee who had worked on Ferranti Mark 1, the firstcommercially built computer.
